

Scripture: Matthew 5:13-16 (NLT)

You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavor? Can you make it salty again? It will be thrown out and

trampled underfoot as worthless.

You are the light of the world - like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house.

In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your Heavenly Father.

We have a two-fold vision of the church:

- To see the love of Christ turn lives around (that's why we are called "Revolution")
- To make our community a better place because we're in it

The church has a two-fold responsibility in the world:

- To equip (evangelize, train, disciple, teach, grow, love, etc.)
- To edify (build up the church)

Ephesians 4:11-13
