Scripture: Galatians 5:13-26 (NLT)

¹³ For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. ¹⁴ For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ But if you are always biting and devouring one another, watch out! Beware of destroying one another.

Living by the Spirit's Power

¹⁶ So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. ¹⁷ The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions. ¹⁸ But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.

¹⁹ When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, ²¹ envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

²² But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!

²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. ²⁵ Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, or provoke one another, or be jealous of one another.

The Spirit, of course, is talking about the Holy Spirit – a part of God the Father, God the Son, Go the Holy Ghost (Spirit).
Spiritual gifts are passed on from God – to you – as a result of your salvation and relationship will Jesus Christ and empowering of supernatural works, wisdom, knowledge, power, etc. active and present in your earthly life.
Gifts are the root of what you in the Spirit and how God himse in you.
Fruit is what is by you through the Holy Spirit, whether in works or in ideals.
In ancient literature, these ideals were called virtue ethics. In Christianity, they are simply the Fruits of the Spirit. They are what a healthy tree produces and then is passed on to others throughout and can as it is used and duplicated.
The Fruit of the Spirit is:
 Love – love is the nature of God. Joy – joy is unspeakable and full of glory Peace – peace surpasses all understanding Patience – patience is a virtue Kindness – kindness is something we should all exhibit to each other Goodness – goodness is a matter of who you are and how you share it Faithfulness – faithfulness is a dedication to God and to others Gentleness – gentleness is a dynamic force and works in humility, honor, grace Self-control – self-control is wise, poised and powerful
Each of these elements can be present in how you one another.
A good spiritual fruit will nourish healthy Christians AND those who are in need.
A bad spiritual fruit will poison and spoil the entire crop.
